Ms Narelle Dickinson	Director and Lead Clinician, Lotus Health and Psychology	According to her website Ms Dickinson 'specialises in surrogacy and donor implications counselling'.
Dr Alison Gee	Fertility Specialist, IVF Australia	Dr Gee is a fertility specialist with clinical expertise in areas including <i>Egg Freezing, Donor and Surrogacy</i> .
Professor Paula Gerber	Law Faculty, Monash University	Professor Gerber has publications advocating that Australia legalise compensated surrogacy .
Mr Michael Gorton AM	Consultant, Russell Kennedy Lawyers	Mr Gorton works for a firm that services healthcare providers. In reviews commissioned by the Victorian and Queensland Governments he has recommended changes to create a more supportive framework for surrogacy.
Her Honour Judge Alexandra Harland	Federal Circuit Court and Family Court of Australia	Justice Harland has written publicly about the need for Australia to expand beyond altruistic surrogacy.
Ms Sarah Jefford OAM	Family Creation Lawyer	Ms Jefford is a family creation lawyer practising in surrogacy and donor conception across Australia. Sarah was an IVF mum, and later became an egg donor and a surrogate, giving birth to a baby in 2018 for two dads.
Dr Jaya Keaney	School of Social and Political Sciences, University of Melbourne	Dr Keaney is the author of <i>Making Gaybies: Queer Reproduction and Multiracial Feeling</i> which is sympathetic to the use of commercial surrogacy.
Ms Rachel Oakeley	Barrister	Ms Oakeley has a special interest in surrogacy and adoption matters and is a regular speaker, including internationally, about fertility law and surrogacy. She provides services to parties entering into surrogacy arrangements and when applying for transfers of parentage.
Mr Stephen Page	Principal, Page Provan family and fertility lawyers, and Secretary, Fertility Society of Australia and New Zealand	Mr Page describes himself as an internationally renowned pioneer in surrogacy matters. He has been accepted as an expert witness in surrogacy cases throughout Australia and in the UK. He has a child obtained through surrogacy.
Professor Jens Scherpe	Aalborg Universitet, Denmark	Professor Scherpe is an authority in comparative family law who has published work on surrogacy concluding in favour of a regulated framework .
Mr Ashley Scott	Executive Officer, Rainbow Families Australia	Mr Scott has two daughters born through surrogacy, and is also a known donor for a Lesbian family.
